



EDU ROBOT CAMP

RULES

1. Edu Robot Camp is an international camp, so the official language of the camp is English.
2. The camp attracts a wide range of campers from many different countries. Be open to your fellow campers and be respectful of each other.
3. During the professional programmes, campers will work in 8 groups, differentiated by age and WRO competition categories. The teams will be assigned by the colour of their armbands. The 8 groups will have 8 group leaders who will assist the campers throughout the week. They are available to answer any questions, queries or problems.
4. On Wednesday, we will go to 3 locations outside the camp area. During the trip and the programme, it is of utmost importance that the instructions of the organisers and the group leaders are followed.
5. Campers must follow the instructions of the group leaders and camp organisers at all times. They can be identified by the badge hanging around their neck.
6. It is forbidden to leave the camp area without the permission of an adult (coach, group leader, camp organiser).
7. Alcohol, cigarettes and drugs of any kind are forbidden!
8. Campers are NOT allowed to leave the accommodation after 22:00 in the evening!
9. Damaging accommodation, classrooms, equipment is strictly forbidden! Campers will be held responsible for any material damage that may occur.
